**On the T.C.H. 105**, Exit 12 turn when you get to 312 Englishtown, Ingonish and we are located 6 km off T.C.H. at the Englishtown wharf, 500 feet before the ferry.

**On the Trail** coming from Ingonish continue straight at the Barrachois intersection on 312 for the Englishtown Ferry. We are located 500 feet on the Baddeck side of the ferry.
